



# **TO OUR DONORS AND COMMUNITY PARTNERS**

In 2016, we continued to focus our attention on the Foundation's mission—enhancing the quality of life for the Bexley community through investing in initiatives that make a positive impact.

Highlights from the year include:

- Twenty-six grants awarded totaling \$235,433! Our total grants reached over \$848,000 which puts us on track to reach \$1 million in grants from all funds by the end of 2017.
- Every dollar raised from the public will be invested in Bexley. Our operating and marketing expenses were fully covered by gifts from our Board of Directors, sponsorships and other designated gifts, and investment income.



• The Foundation continued to expand our portfolio of funds with the addition of two funds in 2016 – Anne and Sam

Powers Fund and the Bexley Public Library Community Author Series Fund. We now have a total of 10 funds.

• The largest grant in the history of the Foundation, \$81,000, was awarded in 2016 to the City of Bexley for the construction of new Alum Creek Park Athletic Fields.

On the following pages, we share the achievements from the year and the impacts we made together. The greater the "we", the more WE can do. It is an exciting future, and you and your support are the key to maintaining Bexley as the top in its class for generations to come!

- (1) Contributions received by the Bexley Community Foundation are transferred into funds held and invested at The Columbus Foundation for our use. These funds are classified as Beneficial Interest in Assets Held by Others on our Statement of Financial Position and are subject to the variance power of the Board of Trustees of The Columbus Foundation.
- (2) During 2016, we awarded \$235,433 in grants and distributed \$119,882 for grants awarded in 2016 and prior years. Due to the timing of our grant cycles and other factors, all or part of a grant is frequently distributed subsequent to the year in which the grant is awarded. At December 31, 2016, \$335,907 of our total assets was designated for previously awarded grants in our various funds for distributions on outstanding grants.
- (3) During 2016, operating expenses were funded by contributions from our Board members, corporate gifts designated for that purpose and investment return on our funds at The Columbus Foundation. Event expenses were funded by contributions from event sponsors. Contributions from the public were used to fund grants.

Our statement of financial position as of December 31, 2016 and the related statements of activities and cash flows for the year then ended were reviewed by Wells, CPA LLC independent accountants, and copies of these statements and our federal tax return (Form 990) for 2016 are available upon request.

In addition, Perfect Balance, CPA generously donates its services to prepare our internal financial statements and provide bookkeeping services.




# **OUR PRIORITIES**

# **GRANTS AWARDED IN 2016**

## **BEXLEY COMMUNITY FUND**

Alum Creek Park Athletic Fields: \$81,000 to the Bexley Recreation and Parks Department for development of a 1.5 acre athletic field to include parking lot with lighting, connection to the Alum Creek Pathway, playground, bike racks, portable restroom facilities, trash receptacles, and emergency call boxes.

**North Bexley Community Garden:** \$40,000 to the City of Bexley for installation of a community garden by the police station in north Bexley.



## **BEXLEY YOUTH & RECREATION FUND**

Alum Creek Athletic Fields Soccer Goals: \$6,000 to the Bexley Recreation and Parks Department for the purchase of four soccer goals for the new Alum Creek Athletic Fields.

**DARN Camp Scholarships:** \$2,000 to DARN scholarships for students to attend summer camps in Bexley.



**Stairway to the Alum Creek Park Pathway:** \$10,000 to the City of Bexley for construction of a stairway to provide a new point of access from Main Street to the Alum Creek Park Pathway.

**Electric Motorcycle:** \$9,552 to the Bexley Police Department for purchase of an electric motorcycle that will patrol hard to reach paths and alleyways and carry an AED.

**Fourth of July Celebration:** \$8,000 to the Bexley Celebrations Association for the 2016 Fourth of July festivities.

## **BEXLEY YOUTH & RECREATION FUND** continued

**Splish, Splash and Dash Youth Triathlon:** \$1,000 to the Bexley Recreation and Parks Department for the fourth annual Bexley youth triathlon which had over 325 participants in 2016.

**Bee Keeping Project:** \$1,000 to the Cub Scout and Boy Scout Troop 166 to purchase additional bees and two new hives.

**1st Annual Book Bash:** \$500 to Books for Bedtime for the First Annual Book Bash, a free event in May 2017 at Maryland Avenue Elementary School featuring guest authors, food trucks, silent auctions, and of course, books!

## **BEXLEY BEAUTIFICATION FUND**

**Commonwealth and Havenwood Park Plan:** \$20,000 to City of Bexley for evaluation of space needed for passive and active recreation use and creation of a master plan.

**Streetscaping along Drexel Avenue and Main Street:** \$13,725 to City of Bexley for a series of whimsical pots clustered in groups of three with plantings rotated seasonally.





**Planter and Flower Basket Materials:** \$12,000 to the City of Bexley for materials used in planters and flower baskets on Drexel Avenue and Main Street.

**Boxwood on City Hall:** \$3,750 to City of Bexley for high quality, artificial boxwoods mounted behind the parapet wall at City Hall.

**Planting Ivy in Main Street Tree Wells:** \$2,000 to the City of Bexley.



**Ford Cowan Eagle Scout Project:** \$300 to Bexley Public Library for installation of astilbe, arborvitae and taxus in the area between the alley and the library.

# **OUR FUNDS**

## **BEXLEY COMMUNITY FUND**

The Bexley Community Fund is our general purpose fund making grants for a full range of Bexley projects and programs and is supported by our annual campaign.

## **BEXLEY YOUTH AND RECREATION FUND**

The Bexley Youth and Recreation Fund is a special purpose fund supporting youth and recreation programs and facilities, including the City's Recreation and Parks Department, and is funded by our annual Meet Me at the Mansion event.

## **JEFFREY MANSION PARK FUND**

The Jeffrey Mansion Park Fund is a special purpose fund for the maintenance and improvement of the mansion and its grounds. The fund is supported by designated gifts from donors. In 2014, the Jeffrey Mansion Park Fund provided funding for the new Parkview Avenue entryway to Jeffrey Mansion. The entryway was completed in 2016.

## **BEXLEY WELLNESS FUND**

The Bexley Wellness Fund is a special purpose fund devoted to activities, programs and services that promote community, family and individual health and wellness in Bexley. The fund was created in 2014 by Beth Grimes-Flood and is supported by designated gifts from donors and grants from organizations interested in health and wellness.

## **DENISE AND BARRY BLANK TREE FUND**

The Denise and Barry Blank Tree Fund is a donor designated fund dedicated to the planting of trees and is supported by gifts from members and friends of the Blank family and other interested donors. Established in 2012 by Denise and Barry Blank, the Blank Tree Fund continues to grow.

## SUSIE AND CHARLIE RATH CREATIVE ARTS FUND

The Susie and Charlie Rath Creative Arts Fund is a donor designated fund established in memory of Susie's father, Leland S. McClelland, a highly regarded local artist and longtime Bexley resident. The fund was established in 2015 to promote the creative arts, including the visual and performing arts, vocal and instrumental music, writing and communication, design and digital and other media in the Bexley community.

## JAY AND JEANIE SCHOTTENSTEIN FAMILY FUND

Established in 2015, the Jay and Jeanie Schottenstein Family Fund is a donor designated fund dedicated to providing financial support to the Foundation and through the Foundation's grant program to other nonprofit organizations serving the Bexley community. The Bexley community has long been a charitable priority of the Schottenstein family, and this fund will advance the mission of the Foundation.

The Anne and Sam Powers Fund is a donor designated fund established in 2016 to promote positive sports experiences for children and youth who participate in school, recreational, and other sports programs serving the Bexley community. The fund will promote child and youth health and wellness and positive values, such as teamwork, sportsmanship and self-confidence, which can be learned through sports. The fund will also support programming to help athletes, parents and coaches develop skills to improve the sports experience and make it fun.



## **BEXLEY PUBLIC LIBRARY COMMUNITY AUTHOR SERIES FUND**

The Bexley Community Foundation teamed up with the Bexley Public Library in 2016 to establish the Bexley Public Library Community Author Series Fund. This fund supports the annual Bexley Community Author Series, which are events that bring authors to Bexley to discuss their works and engage our community.
