In 2018 we created our 12th Fund – the Bexley Celebrations and Events Fund, granted almost \$300,000 to projects and organizations in our community, grew our Capital Campaign for the City's Jeffrey Mansion Project from a \$1 million goal to \$1.5 million, conducted two bus tours on the Bexley Beat to locations of grants funded by the Foundation, attended the weekly Bexley Farmers' Market and so much more. We had fun celebrating the 4th of July, handing out popsicles at the Splish, Splash and Dash Youth Triathlon, volunteering at the Bexley Day of Kindness, watching the daffodils in Drexel Circle bloom, the list goes on and on!

- (1) Contributions received by the Bexley Community Foundation are transferred into funds held and invested at The Columbus Foundation for our use. These funds are classified as Beneficial Interest in Assets Held by Others on our Statement of Financial Position and are subject to the variance power of the Board of Trustees of The Columbus Foundation.
- (2) During 2018, we awarded \$293,185.54 in grants and distributed \$211,712 awarded in 2018 and prior years. Due to the timing of our grant cycles and other factors, all or part of a grant is frequently distributed subsequent to the year in which the grant is awarded. At December 31, 2018, \$298,576 of our total assets was designated for previously awarded grants in our various funds for distributions on outstanding grants.
- (3) During 2018, operating expenses were funded by contributions from our Board members, corporate gifts designated for that purpose and investment return on our funds at The Columbus Foundation. Event expenses were funded by contributions from event sponsors. Contributions from the public were used to fund grants.

Our statement of financial position as of December 31, 2018 and the related statements of activities and cash flows for the year then ended were reviewed by Wells, CPA LLC independent accountants, and copies of these statements and our federal tax return (Form 990) for 2018 are available upon request.

Bexley Community Fund

The Bexley Community Fund is our general purpose fund providing grants to a full range of Bexley projects and programs. The mission of this fund is to support the Foundation and the belief that Bexley is a special place where we **live**, **learn**, **work and play**.

Bexley Beautification Fund

The Bexley Beautification Fund conducts two campaigns each year, Trees for Bexley and Bexley in Bloom, and invests in Bexley's urban forest, the physical environment and community beautification. Fund projects have included replacement trees throughout the City to preserve green areas in every Bexley neighborhood, gateways at the entrances to the community, plantings and lighting at Drexel Circle, trees in the Main and Broad Street medians, and flower baskets on Main Street, Cassady Avenue, and the Broad Street and Clifton Avenue bridges.

Youth and Recreation Fund

The Youth and Recreation Fund was created to benefit community-wide recreational efforts for the next generation of Bexley residents. An integral part of this fund is to support the City's Recreation and Parks Department programs including launching and supporting the annual Splish, Splash and Dash Youth Triathlon along with other recreation projects in our community.

Jeffrey Mansion and Park Fund

The Jeffrey Mansion and Park Fund is a special purpose fund for the maintenance and improvement of Bexley's treasured mansion and grounds. The Parkview Avenue entryway and brick sidewalks leading up to the mansion were sponsored by this fund. Annual gifts from designated donors sustain the Jeffrey Mansion and Park Fund.

Bexley Wellness Fund

The Bexley Wellness Fund is a special purpose fund devoted to activities, programs and services that promote community, family, and individual health in Bexley. The fund was created in 2014 by Beth Grimes-Flood and is funded by both donor gifts and grants from health and wellness organizations.

Bexley Public Library Community Author Series Fund

The Bexley Community Foundation teamed up with the Bexley Public Library in 2016 to establish the Bexley Public Library Community Author Series Fund. The mission of this fund is to provide literary experiences creating a lifelong love of learning in our community. Visiting authors such as Pulitzer Prize winners Colson Whitehead and this year's 2018 author, Elizabeth Strout, have shared novels with the Bexley Community.

Bexley Farmers' Market Fund

The Bexley Farmers' Market Fund was established to support our local Farmers' Market which runs weekly from May through October. Area farmers and Bexley residents come together to shop and socialize on Dawson, just off Main Street, celebrating our wonderful community.

Denise and Barry Blank Tree Fund

The Denise and Barry Blank Tree Fund is a donor designated fund dedicated to the planting of trees throughout Bexley. The fund is supported by members and friends of the Blank family and other Bexley residents who love our National Tree City. Established in 2012, the fund has provided several plantings in Bexley such as trees on Cassady at Fair Avenue, landscaping at the Cassingham Playground, and trees in the medians at City Hall and on Broad Street.

Anne and Sam Powers Fund

The Anne and Sam Powers Fund is a donor designated fund established in 2016 to promote positive sports experiences for youth who participate in school, recreational, and other sports programs serving our Bexley community. Grants from this fund also provide programming to help athletes, parents and coaches develop skills to improve their sports experiences.

Susie and Charlie Rath Creative Arts Fund

The Susie and Charlie Rath Creative Arts Fund is a donor designated fund established in memory of Susie's Father, Leland S. McClelland, a highly regarded local artist and longtime Bexley resident. The fund was established in 2015 to promote the creative arts, including the visual and performing arts, vocal and instrumental music, writing and communication, and design in our Bexley community.

Jay and Jeanie Schottenstein Family Fund

Established in 2015, the Jay and Jeanie Schottenstein Family Fund designates gifts to specific nonprofit organizations serving our community. Bexley has long been a charitable priority of the Schottenstein family and their family's support sustains the mission of the Foundation to live, learn, work and play in Bexley.

Since the Bexley Community Foundation began making grants in 2011, donors have enabled the Foundation to award over 150 grants totaling over \$1.25 million and ranging from \$900-\$81,000. The Foundation's sole mission is to sustain and enhance Bexley as a special place to live, learn, work and play.

The Foundation enables donors to make Bexley a charitable priority and to join with other donors in maximizing the impact of their individual gifts through its grant programs. Every dollar received from public donations is reinvested in the Bexley community, with 100% of the Foundation's operating and fundraising expenses paid by the Board, designated gifts, sponsorships and investment income.

In 2018 the Bexley Community Foundation awarded nearly \$300,000 in grants to programs and organizations within the City of Bexley. Below are a few examples of how the Foundation makes Bexley the place where we

The Jeffrey Family

THE CORNERSTONE AWARD



A Legacy of Philanthropy Through the Ages

The Jeffrey Family legacy for giving started with the first generation of the Jeffrey Family in Columbus, Ohio. Joseph A. and Celia Jeffrey were late-19th century, early-20th century residents of the near east side of Columbus. Through tenacity, talent, good sense, and fortuitous timing, they built a thriving business enterprise, the source of which was The Jeffrey Manufacturing Company, at the time a leading manufacturer of mining machinery equipment in the world. J.A. did his descendants a huge favor by maintaining family ownership of The Jeffrey Manufacturing Company with thoughtful estate planning. Now — seven generations later — his descendants honor him and Celia by continuing their legacy of charitable giving.

Robert Hutchins Jeffrey (1873–1961), J. A. and Celia's son, was instrumental in the founding of the village of Bexley in 1908. In 1941, R.H. (as he is known to the family) donated his estate, named Kelvedon, including the 34-acre grounds and large manor house, to the City of Bexley for use as a community center and recreation complex. It is now known as Jeffrey Mansion.

Another son, Malcolm Douglas Jeffrey (1884-1930), built a home at 358 North Parkview Avenue which was subsequently donated to the State of Ohio and now serves as the Governor's Residence and Heritage Garden.


